Kindergarten Behavior Management

It is an expectation of all children to demonstrate appropriate behavior in class and at school. Teachers have discussed appropriate behavior at school and will continue to throughout the year. The plan below will be implemented to encourage appropriate and positive behavior as well as a way to keep in contact with parents about issues that should be discussed.

Inappropriate Behavior:

- Warning (reminder of rules)
- Thinking time (time away from a grouped setting)
- "Number" on Student Responsibility sheet in Data Folder
- Note home to parents after 2nd "Number"
- Phone call home/ Parent Conference

Positive Behavior:

- Thumbs up/ pat on the back/recognition
- Class earns tokens towards incentives
- Personal tokens to earn incentives
- Positive Notes sent home
- Exemplary Behavior Referrals

A Student Responsibility sheet will go home that will document daily class behavior and work habits. It is to be signed by a parent and returned by the next school day. As a team, the teachers will support and encourage all students to do their best for a successful year!
